### **Camp Counselor Positions Available**

Camp Airy for boys and Camp Louise for girls are brother-sister single-gender camps located in Thurmont, MD and Cascade, MD. Every summer, we host campers ages 7-17, who participate in a diverse range of fun activities, like athletics, arts, music, swimming, outdoors, and much more. Campers come to camp to become more independent and confident, learn new skills, and make friends that last a lifetime. The staff experience is also incredibly special and valuable. Counselors will be able to make a significant positive impact on their campers' lives, gain "real-world" professional skills, and make their own lifelong friends. Past counselors describe the job as challenging, yet extremely rewarding. Camp staff are both role models and rock stars in the eyes of their kids.

At Airy & Louise, camp counselors live "in-bunk" with 12-14 campers and 1 or 2 co-counselors. They split their time between supervising their own group of campers, and facilitating activities in their "department" (i.e. Sports, arts, etc.) Counselors report to a "Unit Leader".

Responsibilities include:

- Ensuring camper safety at all times
- Helping campers follow daily routine (wake-up, brushing teeth, showering, cleaning, etc) and keeping campers on schedule for activities.
- Collaborating with and communicating regularly with co-counselors, supervisors, and other camp staff.
- Planning or assisting to plan programs and activities.
- Work with department head and other department staff to facilitate activities for campers.

All camp staff live on site, at one of our beautiful camps, for the duration of the position (June 14-August 15). Room and board are provided. Weekly days and weekly nights off are given throughout the summer. Due to potential Covid restrictions this summer, it is anticipated that camp may operate in a closed bubble. Time off and other self-care opportunities, on property, would be a regular part of your schedule.
