- Recruit and train volunteers to participate in the political process
- Learn canvassing skills including operating canvassing software, targeting voters with multiple points of contact including voting verification
- Attend party specific events (eg. debates, neighborhood meetings, fundraisers)
- Researching, scheduling and tabling for voter outreach (eg. neighborhood associations, HOA's, community events)

While internships are unpaid, interns can receive credit. Full training and coaching will be provided by senior campaign staffers.

Each intern should expect to help build the Campaign's volunteer base. Interns will gain first-hand experience and exposure to political campaigning at the local level; leaving the Campaign having made lasting connections and developed transferable skills. Experience on the campaign team can be credited to high school, college or university course if applicable.

Anticipated start date for internship is at the candidate's earliest convenience.

Requirements:

- Commitment to work a minimum of 5 hours a week, maximum of 15 hours per week
- Ideal candidates should be highly organized, reliable, prompt, detail-oriented and self-motivated
- An interest in politics and political campaigns is highly desired
- Active social media presence - representing our campaign online professionally
- Willingness to learn voter databases and systems
- Willingness to communicate directly with voters through phone and door to door contact
- Excellent written and oral communication skills
