The Aafiyah Project is a (non-profit) wellness organization addressing health disparities in the DMV area. The scholastic arm of our programming includes the after-school clubs

(https://www.theaafiyahproject.org/aafiyah-clubs), where we focus on topics such as career & college preparedness, conservation, social-emotional learning, and body systems for students from pre-K to 12th grade. We plan to commence with our bi-weekly after-school club meetings in the month of October and are looking for program facilitators to volunteer with us for the school year (October - March). We are looking to fill 4 positions, one for each of the clubs: Kids Club; Jr. STARs; Super STARs; and Senior STARs.

A majority of the activities will take place virtually, via Zoom.

Program Facilitator Job Responsibilities:

- Plans, leads, and implements after-school programs for children.
- Provides high-quality educational and recreational opportunities and enjoyable experiences for students.
- Supervises students and ensures their safety, development, growth, skill achievement, and general well-being.
- Facilitates and creates lesson plans for bi-monthly after-school club.
- Organizes and leads various small and large group activities.
- Cleans up after use of learning center.
- Assists in maintaining accurate program records, including incident reports, logbook documentation, and student attendance.
- Mediates any students' disputes.
- Knows, enforces, and follows all safety guidelines associated with students including knowing the whereabouts of your charges at all times.
