

Non-Emergency Incident and Injury Reporting - Laboratories

The following information outlines reporting following a non-emergency incident, such as a minor injury, exposure, spill, or near-miss. In the event of any incident or injury, notify the professor, lecturer, or supervisor. After the scene is stable and any injury has been attended to, use the information below to report, and get help if needed.

1. Contact Environmental Health and Safety (EHS), 240-665-6417, usgehs@umd.edu. Laboratories have an [EMERGENCY PROCEDURES POSTER](#) listing this information.
2. As soon as possible after the event has stabilized, fill out an [Incident Report Form](#) on the EHS webpage.
3. Notify the environmental health and safety department at your home institution to meet any of their campus-specific requirements. If the incident involves a work-related injury or illness, the employee and supervisor should fill out work-related reporting forms.
4. If additional medical consultation or advice is needed, your home institution's health center is a resource.
