Full-Time (12+ credits) Undergraduate Students:

- In-State: \$4,102
- Out-of-State: \$10,716
- Shady Grove Auxiliary Fee: \$325 per semester
- Shady Grove Facilities Fee: \$20 per semester
- Shady Grove Technology Fee: \$151 per semester

Part-Time (1-11 credits) Undergraduate Students:

- In-State: \$341 per credit
- Out-of-State: \$890 per credit
- Shady Grove Auxiliary Fee: \$27.20 per credit
- Shady Grove Facilities Fee: \$10 per semester
- Shady Grove Technology Fee: \$15 per credit

Financial Aid Information

FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov)

- UMBC's FAFSA School Code: 002105
- To be eligible for aid, you must file an updated FAFSA each year.
- For UMBC Aid: FAFSA must arrive at Federal Processor by February 14th prior to the academic year for which you are applying for aid.
- For State of Maryland Aid: FAFSA must arrive at Federal Processor by March 1st prior to the academic year for which you are applying for aid.

UMBC Financial Aid Packages

- Financial Aid Award Notifications are sent beginning in late March via *myUMBC*.
- If you just completed your FAFSA or were recently admitted to UMBC, you will be able to access your award notification 2-3 weeks after the date of submission of your FAFSA or the date you are admitted, whichever is later.
