#### I. Welcome & Announcements

Chair announced BOA Revised Bylaws including specifically the changes to
ensure that USG BOA meetings are open to the public and that the BOA has
increased the number of potential members. Chair also indicated that the BOA
Work in AY21-22 would align with, and be balanced to make time for, the
strategic plan work.

- BOA Officers discussed where members will be engaged to support the USG Strategic Plan
  - Strategic Plan:
    - Members will be invited to participate in work Groups in September-November.
    - Members will be asked to shape a sustainable fiscal model-specifically to help define what services, what revenue, what needs must be addressed in a new model. The Financial Resources Committee will be activated following the development of recommendations by the strategic plan work group.
    - BOA members will be asked to help focus investment on strategic initiatives (pathways not degrees) and work to ensure that USG serves as a crucible of innovation. Specifically, the BOA members will be asked about possibility of convening a community learning event that helps to drive progress by pushing new ideas. The Executive Committee agreed to

bring to the full BOA a discussion of the BOA hosting such an event to support USG in the thought leadership role.


