

Public Speaking / Oral Communication

Students will demonstrate the ability to articulate thoughts and ideas clearly and effectively in their public speaking by

- Using syntax, grammar, and/or vocabulary appropriate to the context and modality.
- Organizing messages clearly and consistently with any supporting material.
- Tailoring the message and delivery method to the topic, purpose, and context
- Framing message with respect to diversity of learning styles
- Framing message with respect to cultural differences

Assessment methods:

1. A checklist, e.g.,
 - Syntax and grammar are appropriate
 - Vocabulary is appropriate
 - Message is organized clearly
 - Message uses supporting material
 - Message is tailored to topic, purpose, context
 - Delivery method of message is tailored to topic, purpose, context
 - Message is tailored to audience
 - Message is framed with respect to diversity of learning styles
 - Message is framed with respect to cultural differences
 - Delivery method is tailored to audience
 - Delivery method is framed with respect to diversity of learning styles
 - Delivery method is framed with respect to cultural differences
2. Could develop a rubric using similar items and rating scale
