- Accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) and approved by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE).

Program Information

The Towson undergraduate program in Early Childhood Education is a program that prepares students for certification in early childhood education (birth to age 8). This program is a two year, full-time program where students complete their junior and senior years at The Universities at Shady Grove (USG) and in Montgomery County Public School classrooms.

To be considered for admission, students must:

- Submit an application and official transcripts of all college work
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 and a C or better on ALL courses.
- Be enrolled in the Early Childhood Education/Early Childhood Special Education A.A.T. program at Montgomery College or Frederick Community College.

STEPS to a Bachelor of Science Degree in EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION (ECED)



The ECED program begins new cohorts every fall. We do NOT offer spring admissions. Cohorts are limited in the number of students who will be accepted.

1. Apply to Towson University at USG in the Fall, one year before transferring from the A.A.T. in Early Childhood Education/Early Childhood Special Education programs at Montgomery College or Frederick Community College.
2. Submit official transcripts from all colleges attended. Transcripts should be hand delivered to the Towson University Site Coordinator at USG ONLY at the fall event at USG. After the fall event at USG, transcripts should be sent directly to Towson University's Undergrad Admissions Office.
3. Get accepted to Towson University. It is the first step to admission to the USG program; however, it does not equal admission to the Towson University Early Childhood Education program at Towson at the Universities at Shady Grove.
4. Get admitted to the TU ECE program at USG. To be considered for admission to the TU ECE program at USG, students must:
 - Be enrolled in the Early Childhood Education/Early Childhood Special Education A.A.T. program at Montgomery College or Frederick Community College.
 - Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 (based on all colleges attended)
5. Complete the digital TU Enrollment Contract AFTER you have been admitted to the TU Early Childhood Education program at USG.
6. Attend new student orientation at USG in June. Bring a copy of your unofficial transcript.
